d. the clear liquid that comes through your skin when you are hot, nervous, or doing exercise



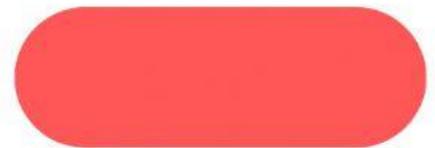
e. to become red in the face, especially when you are embarrassed or ashamed
