A 〈Be〉동사의 과거시제

① 〈Be〉동사의 과거시제는 '～이었다'의 뜻을 가지며, 〈was, were〉의 두 종류가 있다.

② 〈Be〉동사의 부정은 〈Be + not〉이다. 〈Be〉동사의 의문문은 〈Be〉동사를 주어 앞에 둔다.

대답은 〈Yes, ~ was/were.〉 또는 〈No, ~ wasn't/weren't.〉로 한다.

③ 과거시제와 함께 쓰는 시간 표현은 다음과 같다.

- yesterday, yesterday morning/afternoon/evening (어제, 어제 아침/점심/저녁에)
- last night, last week/month (어제 밤에, 지난 주/달에)
- last year, last spring/summer/fall/winter (작년에, 작년 봄/여름/가을/겨울에)
- two hours/days/months/years ago (두 시간/이틀/두 달/2년 전에)

B 일반동사의 과거시제: 규칙동사 Regular Verbs

① 과거시제는 어제, 지난 주, 작년 등 과거의 일을 나타낼 때 쓰며, '～했었다'의 뜻을 가진다.

② 과거시제의 의문문에 대한 긍정은 〈Yes, 주어 + did.〉, 부정은 〈No, 주어 + didn't.〉로 대답한다.

③ 일반동사의 과거형 만드는 규칙

- 대부분의 동사는 끝에 〈-ed〉를 붙인다. (answer → **answered**)
- 〈e〉로 끝나는 동사는 〈-d〉를 붙인다. (arrive → **arrived**)
- 〈단모음+단자음〉으로 끝나는 동사는 자음을 한 번 더 쓰고 〈-ed〉를 붙인다. (stop → **stopped**)
- 〈자음+y〉로 끝나는 동사는 〈y〉를 〈i〉로 바꾸고 〈-ed〉를 붙인다. (try → **tried**)
