• Las predicciones que hacemos con “will” son menos probables que ocurran que si las hacemos con “be going to”. • Su abreviatura es <i>//</i> para la afirmativa y <i>won't</i> para la negativa. • Expresa predicciones basadas en opiniones o experiencias personales. • Sirve para expresar decisiones que se han tomado en el instante. • Se usa porque pensamos que algo va a ocurrir.	• Las predicciones que hacemos con “be going to” son más probables que ocurran que si las hacemos con “will”. • Su abreviatura se realiza en el mismo verbo “to be”. • Expresa predicciones basadas en evidencias presentes. • Sirve para expresar acciones que se han planeado con anterioridad (planes). • Se usa porque vemos que algo va a ocurrir.
