1	this displays commands for opening, saving and printing documents.		
2	this bar displays the file name and the program name. It also displays the minimize, restore and Close buttons.		
3	These are horizontal bars near the top of the program's window that is designed to help you quickly find the commands that you need to complete a task.		
4	are instructions that carry out an action when clicked. They can be selected from the Quick Access Toolbar or the Ribbon.		
5	opens a different ribbon and gives you quick access to the commonly used commands that you need to complete a task.		
6	this allows you to select items or to move to a specific position where you would like to put the cursor.		
7	brings unseen parts of a document into view, located at the right side and bottom.		
8	display the margins, tab settings and indents in documents, located at the top 8 left side.		
9	a flashing vertical line that indicates where the next character typed will be inserted.		
10	can be found at the bottom right and it is used to zoom in and out and view your document easier.		
11	displays information about the current document. (# of pages and # of words etc.) document easier.		
12	lets you change how the document appears and are located at the bottom right.
