Rules

- Add -s or -es to form present-tense singular verbs. Before adding -es to singular verbs ending in a consonant and y, change y to i.
- Add -d or -ed form past-tense verbs. To add -ed to verb s ending in a consonant and y, change y to i. To add -ed to one-syllable verbs ending in one vowel and one consonant, double the consonant.
