

COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES

there are two ways

SHORT

- Add "-er" at the end of the adjective.
- Add than ... after the adjective.
- If the adjective ends in -e, just add r

*late → later than

 If the adjective ends in consonant, vowel, consonant, double the last consonant

*big → bigger than

- If the adjective **ends in -y**, change the **y to i**

*happy → happier than

- Add 'more" before the adjective.

LONG

- Add than ... after the adjective.
- Two syllable adjectives not ending in -Y

*modern → more modern than

- All adjectives of 3 or more syllables

*expensive → more expensive tan

 We use more + adjective for adverbs than end in -ly:

man one in

- more slowly
- more quietly
- more seriously
- more carefully
- Also: more often
- But: earlier (not 'more early')
- IRREGULAR
- good → better than
- bad → worse than
- far → farther/further .. than
