have to

+	I have to help.	-	I don't have to help.
	He has to help.		He doesn't have to help.
	Do you have to help?		Yes, I do . / No, I don't .
?	Does she have to help?		Yes, she does . / No, she doesn't .
	What do you have to do?		

must, mustn't

+	I must clean up.	-	They mustn't clean up.
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I **have to** help mum. = I **must** help mum. (= It's necessary.)

You **don't have to** help mum. (= It isn't necessary.)

You **mustn't** mix up the chillies and peppers. (= Don't do it!)
