_____ : The box that has got the peripheral control units of a computer. For example, the power supplies, the motherboard or the memory.

_____ : Device that is fixed inside the computer and is used to store programs and data. It has a circle name.

_____ : It is a tool for installing and removing screws. There is a big variety of them. You can find them big, small, long or short. They have a handle and a tip. The tip can have different forms but the most typical are blade-type and cross-head.

_____ : Thick wire or group of wires inside a rubber or plastic covering, which is used to carry electricity or electronic signals. It can be very long or very short.

_____ : Small device that can be connected to a computer. You can copy and store information in it.

_____ : The screen of a computer.

_____ : Pair of devices that change electrical signals into sounds, so that we can listen to them at a distance. You usually need two of them.

_____ : Pair of small loudspeakers that you wear around your head and over your ears. With them you can listen privately to an audio source. They have to be connected to the audio source using a cable or using wireless technology.

_____ : Device connected to a computer that captures real-time images and video. It is built into laptops but are separate units attached to the monitor on a desktop computer.

_____ : Also known as notebook. It is a small computer without a case that you can take with you and use over your lap. Its screen closes over its keyboard.

_____ : Sheet of plastic in a computer that makes it possible for the other parts of it to communicate with each other. It is the main printed circuit board (PCB).

_____ : Small plastic disc where sound can be recorded. It is specially used to record music. They are hardly used today.

_____ : Machine that can be connected to a computer in order to make copies on paper. You can get copies in colours or only black and white and you can print two-sided or one-sided.

_____ : Pair of small loudspeakers that you wear around your head and into your ears. With them you can listen privately to an audio source. They have to be connected to the audio source using a cable or using wireless technology.

_____ : Board with lots of keys arranged in rows. You type on it when you want to put information into a computer. It can be wireless or connected to a computer case by a cable.

_____ : Small handheld device which you move across a mat or flat surface to move the cursor on a computer screen.

_____ : Type of telephone that does not need wires.

_____ : A thin flat piece of material on which you move the mouse of a computer.

_____ : Device that converts sound waves into an electronic signal. You use it to make your voice louder, to record it or to broadcast it.
