

Quotation marks always need to go at the start and end of what is being said. There should always be punctuation before the final set of quotation marks; this could be a *comma*, an *exclamation point* or a *question mark*:

"Are you coming to the pictures?" asked John.

"I love that movie!" Lisa exclaimed.

"Let's have chicken for dinner," Jeremy said.
