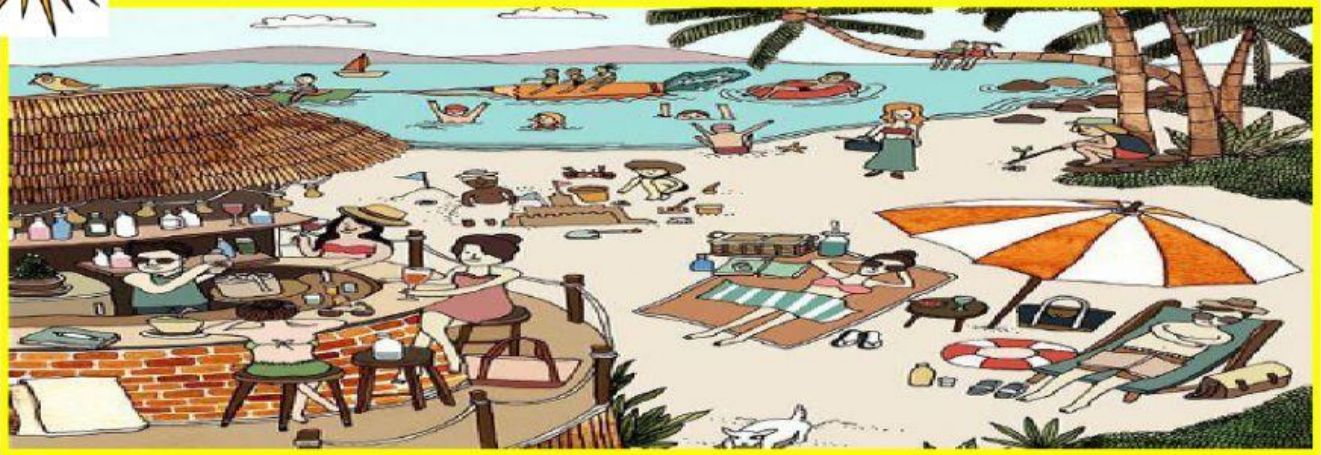




AT THE BEACH
