

The City Circle Tram service provides a free and convenient way to get around central Melbourne. Tourists, shoppers, office workers and families can use the City Circle Tram to travel to major attractions, shops and city events.


The City Circle Tram travels around the city. The tram will take you past shopping malls and arcades, and major attractions such as the City Museum, Parliament House, Docklands, Federation Square, Melbourne Museum and the Princess Theatre.

Information leaflets, including a map of the city are available on board each City Circle Tram. The City Circle Tram can be used as a 'hop on - hop off' service. This way tourists can enjoy each of Melbourne's tourist attraction sites. They can also experience the traditional way of Melbourne transport. One journey takes nearly 50 minutes.

To catch the free City Circle Tram service, just wait at any of the specially marked stops on the route. The City Circle Tram runs every 12 minutes between 10 am and 6 pm Sunday to Wednesday and until 9 pm Thursday to Saturday.


