



**MY TREE HOUSE, IN CENTRAL PUBLIC LIBRARY, SINGAPORE**

In the world's first "green library" for children, there is a tree house made of recycled bottles donated by supporters. There children can read, explore and learn about the environment in a fun and interactive way.

**BIBLO TØYEN, IN OSLO, NORWAY**

Adults are not allowed in Norway's first library only for kids (10 to 15 years old). There are great books there, but the library also offers other educational activities in areas such as drama, music, cooking, computer programming and 3D printing.

Sat-Sun: 12 p.m. to 4 p.m.
