

COMPARATIVE AND SUPERLATIVE ADJECTIVES

Comparative adjectives

We use comparative adjectives when we compare two people, places, animals or objects.
Elephants are taller than horses.
Giraffes are taller than elephants.

Adjectives change to comparative adjectives like this.

Short adjectives: + er / + r

Adjective	Comparative adjective
tall	taller
big*	bigger
nice	nicer

* Double the final consonant in adjectives that end vowel + consonant: *big* → *bigger*

Adjectives ending with -y


Adjective	Comparative adjective
hungry	hungrier
friendly	friendlier

Long adjectives
(two or more syllables)

Adjective	Comparative adjective
difficult	more difficult
intelligent	more intelligent

Irregular adjectives

Adjective	Comparative adjective
good	better
bad	worse



We can use comparative adjectives after **be, look, get and feel**.

We usually use **than** after comparative adjectives.
They're more expensive than apples.

We can sometimes use a comparative adjective on its own to describe a change.
The weather's getting colder. (= colder than it was before)
I feel better now. (= better than I felt yesterday)
