Accidental inventions

Scientists and inventors work hard to design new things, but some great inventions happen accidentally. Three of these inventions have one thing in common – the scientists didn't try to invent them!

- 1 Percy Lebaron Spencer was an American engineer. In 1945, he invented the microwave oven – but he didn't try to invent it! He worked with radio signals. One day at work, a bar of chocolate in his pocket melted. Spencer experimented with different food items. The radio signals cooked them perfectly.
- 2 In 1968, a scientist called Spencer Silver made some new glue. It didn't stick things very well. His company didn't develop it. Seven years later, his friend thought of a use for this glue: sticky notes.
- 3 Sir Timothy Berners-Lee is an English computer scientist. In 1989, he developed a new communication system for computers. In 1990, he and Robert Cailliau created the World Wide Web. At the time, they didn't imagine the impact of the invention. The Web grew quickly. After a few years, it connected millions of people around the world.
- 4 One day in 1941, George de Mestral took his dog for a walk. Some plant seeds stuck to both of them. De Mestral didn't know why this happened. He looked at his clothes and the seeds with a microscope. Then he copied the design carefully and invented Velcro.
