The clothes can be made not only from a cotton, wool or silk. A company in Taiwan produces a fabric from the unlikely source: old coffee grounds. The amount used to make one cup of coffee is enough for three T-shirts. Right now, a fabric is mostly used in sportswear. It has five times the UV protection of cotton.
