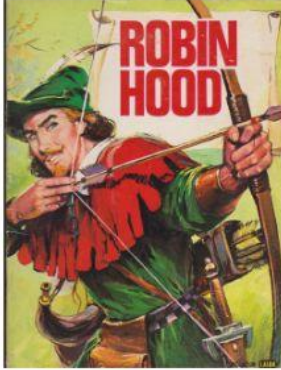




READING COMPREHENSION
