



Usually → Do you **usually** exercise ? Are you **usually** at the gym on week-ends ?

Often → He **often** takes a taxi- He is **often** at his office.

Everyday → They walk to school **everyday**- He is at this office **everyday**.

On Mondays → He is never at home **on Mondays**

Once a week → They exercise at the fitness centre **once a week**.
