My dish is called brigadeiro. If feijoada is the national dish, I guess this is the national dessert. They are made with condensed milk, chocolate powder, butter, and usually sprinkles or some sort of decorative addition to the outer layer. It is hard to stop eating them!

I have avocado ice cream, right, Livia? Yep! We say abacate for avocado. The abacates in Brazil are huge! ... It's time to catch out our train.

This is the Cristo Redentor or 'Christ the Redeemer'. It is one of the new Seven Wonders of the World. The statue was finished in 1931. You said 'cris-two heh-dent-tor' right? It is much bigger than I expected. Yes and the arms stretch nearly as wide as the statue is tall, Molly. We can see nearly all of Rio from the base of the statue.
