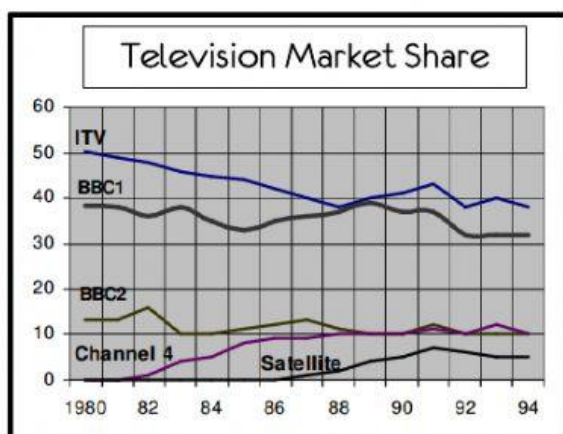

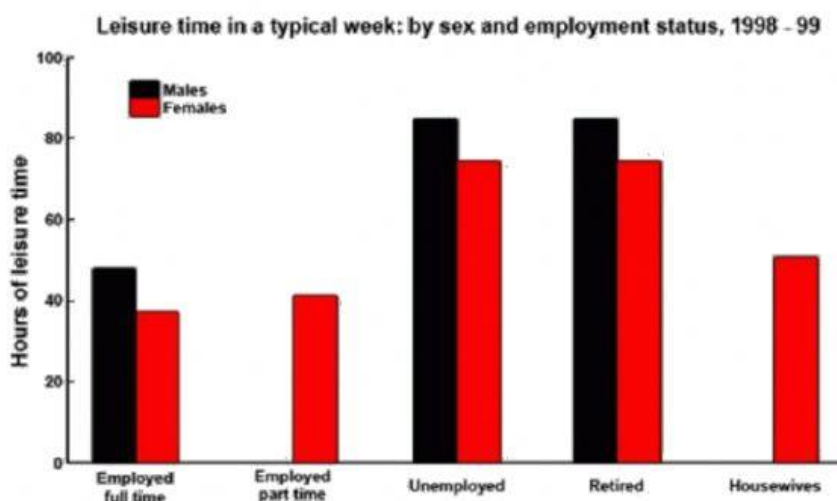

E. The chart below shows the amount of leisure time enjoyed by men and women of different employment status. Complete the report adding words that describe the information shown below.



The (1) \_\_\_\_\_ compares the amount of (2) \_\_\_\_\_ time per week that males and females of (3) \_\_\_\_\_ categories of employment status had between (4) \_\_\_\_\_ and (5) \_\_\_\_\_.

It is clear that men enjoyed more (6) \_\_\_\_\_ of leisure time per week than women in (7) \_\_\_\_\_ out of five categories. However, only figures for women are shown in two categories, namely (8) \_\_\_\_\_ and (9) \_\_\_\_\_.
