

# COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES

<b>One-syllable adjectives</b> 	long - longer straight - straighter big - bigger	tall - taller large - larger hot - hotter
<b>Two-syllable adjectives</b> 	honest - more honest happy - happier narrow - narrower	famous - more famous crazy - crazier gentle - gentler
<b>Three or more syllables</b>	expensive - more expensive popular - more popular confident - more confident	dangerous - more dangerous beautiful - more beautiful difficult - more difficult
<b>Irregular adjectives</b> 	good - better bad - worse far - farther	many - more little - less far - further
