


# There is .../ There are ...

## Is there ... ?/ Are there ... ?

- ❖ We use “**there is**” and “**there are**” to state the existence or presence of something or someone.
- ❖ The singular form is “**There is ...**”.
- ❖ The plural form is “**There are ...**”
- ❖ When asking a question you use “**Is there ...?**” or “**Are there ...?**”



There is a book on the table.



There are books on the table.
