

# SUPERLATIVE ADJECTIVES

## Superlative Adjectives



### What are the superlative adjectives?

- Superlative adjectives are used to describe an object which is at the upper or lower limit of a quality.
- They are used in sentences where a subject is compared to a group of objects.

Examples: the **oldest**, the **most interesting**, the **angriest**, the **largest**.

### How are they formed?

#### One-syllable words

We add "est" or "st" at the end of the adjective and "the" before.

- Simple → Simplest
- Short → Shortest
- Big → Biggest
- High → Highest
- Cheap → Cheapest
- Cold → Coldest

#### two or more syllable words

We add "the most" before the adjective.

- Intelligent → The most intelligent
- Famous → The most famous
- Beautiful → The most beautiful
