Neurčitý člen A/AN – použijí pouze v jednotném čísle s počítatelným podstatným jménem.

*I need **a** pencil. I want **an** apple.*

SOME - znamená „nějaké“ (počítatelné), nebo „trochu“ (nepočítatelné)

- použijí v kladné oznamovací větě

*I have **some** cheese.*

*She wants **some** apples.*

Výjimka: použijeme v otázce, na kterou očekáváme kladnou odpověď:

*Can I have **some** bread, please?*

ANY - znamená „nějaké“ v otázce

*Have you got **any** money?*

- znamená „žádné“ záporné větě

*I haven't got **any** money.*
