

Have to and Can

RULES

We use have to to say that something is necessary.

We use can to say that something is possible.

We use don't have to to say that something is not necessary.

We use can't, NOT don't have to, to say that something is impossible or not allowed.

To make questions with can, we put can before the subject.

To make questions with have to, we add do or does before the subject.

EXAMPLES

Without a visa, you _____ go to USA.

We _____ to leave the hotel until midday.

_____ go to work today?

I _____ get up early tomorrow to go to the airport.

_____ take food and drink on the plane?
