A. GRAMMAR

Present perfect (Thì hiện tại hoàn thành)

- **Thì hiện tại hoàn thành** dùng để **diễn tả một hành động, sự việc đã bắt đầu từ trong quá khứ, kéo dài đến hiện tại và có thể tiếp tục xảy ra trong tương lai.**

Positive	S + have/has + V _{3/ed} .	Ex: She has sent letters to her friends.
Negative	S + have/has + not + V _{3/ed} .	Ex: He has not eaten what she cooked.
Question	Have/Has + S + V _{3/ed} ? Wh- + have/has+ S + V _{3/ed} ?	Ex: Have you eaten lunch? - Yes, I have. Where have you been since January?

- Dấu hiệu nhận biết: **just = recently = lately, already, since, before, never, ever, yet, so far = until now = up to now = up to the present, for + khoảng thời gian, since + mốc thời gian cụ thể, the first/ second... time, etc.**

Ex: **I have not met him since 2019.**

She hasn't told me about you yet.

I have never been to Thailand.

*Note: **have/has not = haven't/hasn't**
