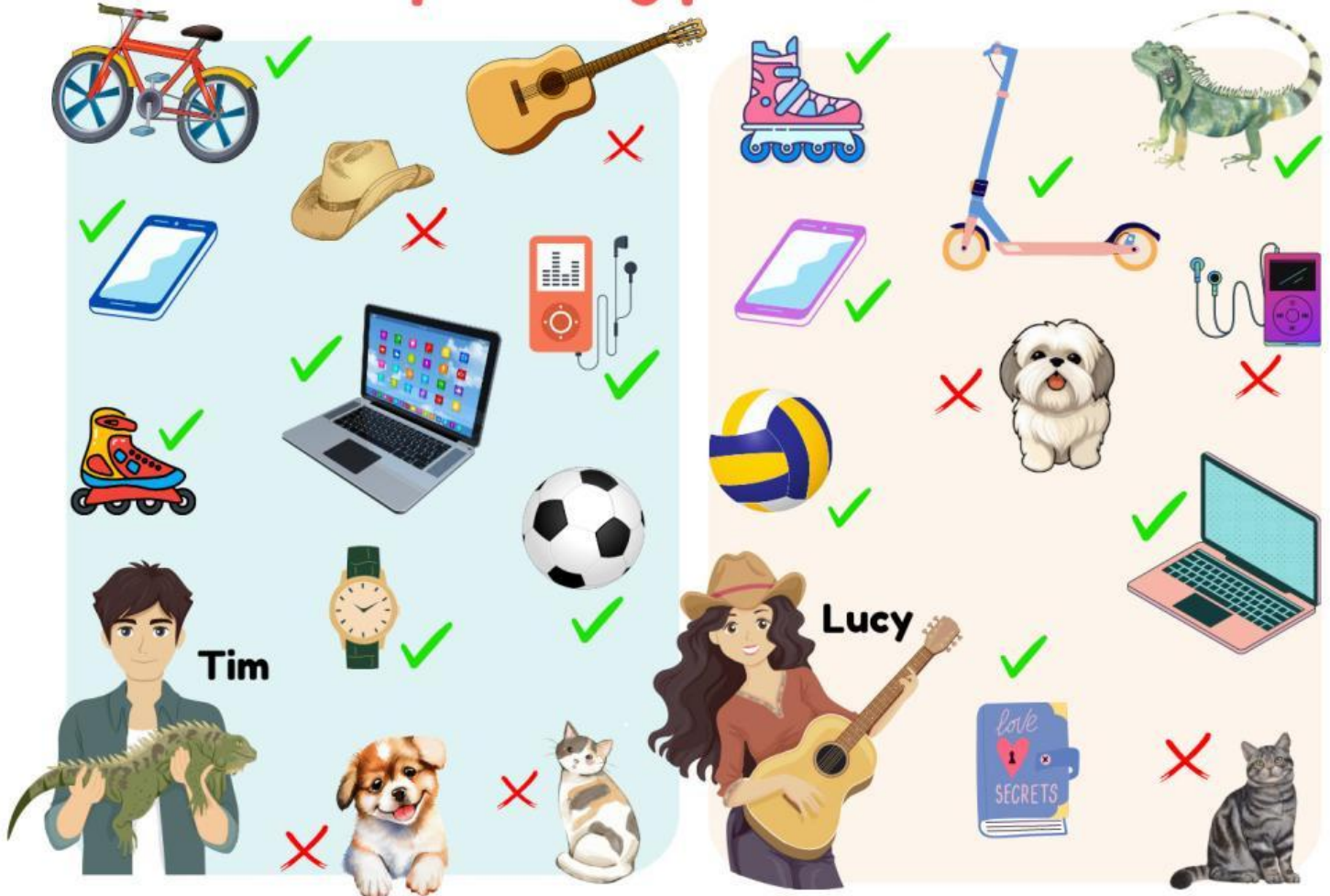


Expressing possession
