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3. He was very nervous during his first interview. It was the Times newspaper.

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4. My next door neighbour works as a gardener. She's a qualified layer.

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5. She had prepared well for the job interview. It lasted nearly two hours.

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6. Our French teacher wants to move to France and open a hotel. Her husband is from Paris.

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7. My cousin did a second degree in computer science. He first degree was in Math.

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8. I wrote an application letter. I forgot to post it.

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9. John is a policeman. His father is a doctor.

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10. Robert Pattinson is an actor. He plays in the Twilight Saga.

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
