

LES QUESTIONS

- L'ordre des mots dans une question est en général :
 (Mot interrogatif) + auxiliaire + sujet + verbe (+ complément)
 seulement lorsque la question est ouverte do / did have à l'infinitif au participe passé

→ When did she start playing music?

→ Where do you go?

→ What have they done?



SAUF...

- avec le **verbe BE**, qui n'a **pas besoin d'auxiliaire**.
→ **What is** your favourite class?
- lorsqu'un **mot interrogatif est sujet**, la question se construit comme une phrase affirmative, et donc **sans auxiliaire** pour les temps simples.
→ **What makes** this boy a "genius"?
→ **Who won** Britain's got talent in 2016?

- Les différents mots interrogatifs :
What (chose) ; **When** (date) ; **Where** (lieu) ; **Why** (raison) ; **Who** (personne) ; **How** (moyen)
