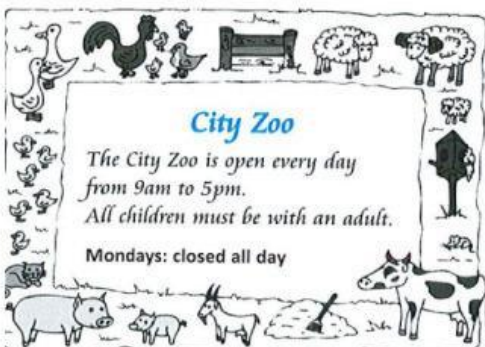

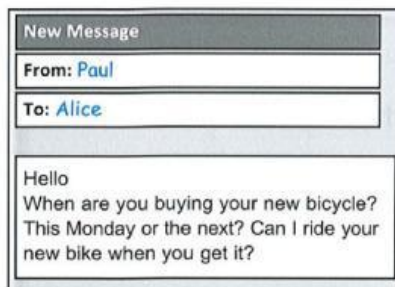

Abdul

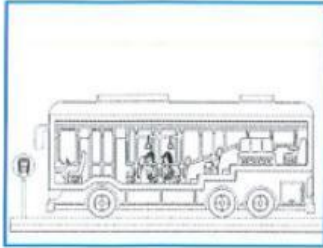
