
She (live)<sup>6</sup> ..... with the dwarfs and took care of them and they (love)<sup>7</sup> ..... her dearly.

12. a chair that can be collapsed flat for easy storage or transport.
13. a small knife that folds into a case and is usually carried in a pocket.
