

Questions in simple present, simple past and will-future

A.) Ask questions in **simple present** with do/does or am/is/are. Use question words in numbers 4 and 5.

1. Joey **is** at home.
2. John and Tommy **are** very good friends.
3. Henry and Lisa **often meet** for dinner.
4. Mary rides her horse **every weekend**.
5. Mike rides his bike **to school** every day.

B.) Ask questions in **simple past** with did or was/were. Use question words in numbers 4 and 5.

1. Frank **was** not at home last night.
2. Steve and Susan **talked** on the phone all night.
3. Don **cooked** dinner on Monday.
4. Scott and Kenny were **at the park** last weekend.
5. Amy bought **six** new shirts.

C.) Ask questions in the future tense with will. Use question words in numbers 4 and 5.

1. John **will work** in his father's shop after he finishes school.
2. Scott and Tommy **will always be** friends.
3. Henry **won't travel** around Europe next summer.
4. Lisa will move to **Berlin** someday.
5. Amy and Nancy won't go to university, **because they want to learn a job**.
