



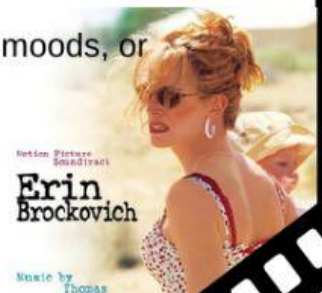
Eric Brockovich-the review

'Erin Brockovich' is a true story about one woman's courageous fight against the whole society. The actors, especially Julia Roberts, who won the Oscar award for Best Actress, give moving and believable performances, and the directing is excellent. This film is well worth seeing.
