| plural nouns: add -s' example: boys → boys' |  The boys' <u>bicycles</u> are blue.  <i>They belong to the boys.</i> |
| some irregular plural nouns: add -'s example: children → children's |  The children's <u>bicycles</u> are blue.  <i>They belong to the children.</i> |
