

UNLESS – ONLY IF – EVEN IF

REMEMBER!

UNLESS: it is used to talk about **EXCEPTIONS.**

I won't take a taxi **unless** there are buses available.

I will sleep early today **unless** there's a party right now.

ONLY IF: The consequence is **possible under one condition.**

I would eat vegetables, **only if** my mother cooked them.

I would go to the party, **only if** my best friends asked me.

EVEN IF: The consequence will always be possible whether the condition is possible or not - **the consequence will happen no matter.**

Even if I were poor, I wouldn't become a thief.

I would never wear skinny jeans, **even if** they paid me to.
