

## Like

positive +	negative –
I like dancing.	I don't like running.
She likes dancing.	She doesn't like running.
He likes dancing.	He doesn't like running.
You like dancing.	You don't like running.
We like dancing.	We don't like running.
They like dancing.	They don't like running.
