

Adverbs

- We use adverbs to describe how something happens or how someone does something.

	Adjective	Adverb
add <i>-ly</i>	<i>slow</i> <i>careful</i> <i>quiet</i> <i>quick</i> <i>bad</i> <i>loud</i> <i>beautiful</i>	<i>Walk slowly in the classroom.</i> <i>Listen carefully to the teacher.</i> <i>Work together quietly, please.</i> <i>Finish your lunch quickly.</i> <i>You don't draw badly!</i> <i>Don't speak loudly, please.</i> <i>He sings beautifully.</i>
change <i>-y</i> to <i>-i</i> , add <i>-ly</i>	<i>easy</i>	<i>I can do this homework easily.</i>
irregular	<i>good</i>	<i>You can play football very well!</i>
stay the same	<i>fast</i> <i>hard</i>	<i>She can run fast.</i> <i>Look hard at the sentence. Can you see the mistake?</i>
