AIBO

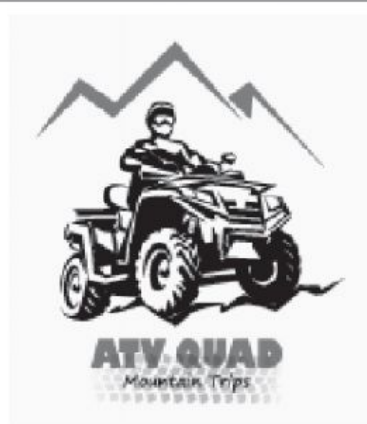
