Is a natural disaster natural?



A natural disaster is the effect of a natural **hazard**-flood, tornado, hurricane, volcanic eruption, earthquake, heat wave, landslide, avalanche, tsunami or forest fire. It leads to financial, environmental or human losses. The resulting loss depends on the **vulnerability** of the affected population to resist the hazard, also called their **resilience**. This understanding is concentrated in this formulation: disasters **occur** when hazards meet vulnerability. Thus a natural hazard will not result in a natural disaster in areas without vulnerability, e.g. strong earthquakes in uninhabited areas. The term natural has consequently been **disputed** because the events simply are not hazards or disasters without human involvement.
