AFTER YOU READ

ACTIVITY 1: List five ways in which Mr Foster delays his wife on her two journeys to the airport.

What do you think Mrs Foster hears as she stands at the front door just before leaving for the airport the second time?

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ACTIVITY 2: Who is being described in questions (a) and (b) and who is speaking to whom in questions (c) - (g)

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- c) I warned Mr Foster that you must leave at 9.15.
