### **Problem Solving- Addition and Subtraction**

**Instructions: Read and answer each question:**

The library is being relocated. The librarians are busy organizing the books.

1. On Monday there were **2 549** fiction books delivered to the library, and **4 936** nonfiction books delivered. How many books were delivered to the library on Monday *all together*?
2. Out of the **2 549** fiction books delivered the librarian takes out **435** to put on the shelf. How many more books will be left to put on the shelf?
3. Then, she takes out **1 955** of the nonfiction books to put on the shelf. How many more nonfiction books will remain to be placed onto the shelf?
4. When she returned on Tuesday to finish restocking the books she noticed some of them were missing. Out of the **fiction books** that she had **left** to stock from Monday, 978 were missing. How many fiction books are now in the library? (*Hint: refer to question 2*)
5. Of the **4 936** nonfiction books in the library, **1 955** of them were about animals, **356** of them were auto-biographies and the **remaining** nonfiction books were biographies. How many of the books were biographies?
