Sure! said Milo. They started their trip, riding the Centipede, his boot slipped on the wet floor because there was slime from a big **Slug**.

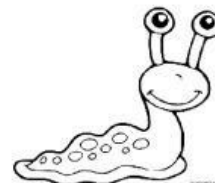
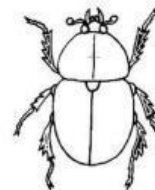
Caterpillar : Oh no! it shouted.
