Affirmative

I/You/We/They want to travel.
He/She wants to travel.

Information Questions Question

What do you want to be?
Where does he want to go?
When does she want to travel?
Who do they want to visit?
How do you want to pay?

Negative

I/You/We/They don't want to travel.
He/She doesn't want to travel.

Answer

I want to be a movie star.
He wants to go to the beach.
She wants to travel on Sunday.
They want to visit their grandparents.
I want to pay with my credit card.
