Examples of shrubs are Rose Plant, Cotton Plant and Bougainvillea Plant.

Herbs are small plants.

Their stems are soft and usually green.

They live for a short time.

The banana plant is the biggest herb.

Examples of herbs are Mint, Wheat and Coriander.

Climbers are plants that it cannot stand straight because they have thin and weak stems.

They need a support to climb up.

Examples of climbers are Beanstalk, Money Plant and Grapevine




