1. Read the following news article about a traffic accident in Peru.



A terrible accident occurred on the road to Ayacucho yesterday night. [A] A rescue team and firefighters have been there for 5 hours in order to find more victims at Humay district.

It was about 11.30 pm, when a bus, which was traveling from Lima to Ayacucho 'Los Libertadores' highway, crashed into a big hill. Some witnesses said that it was because the brakes **might not have been** working well, while some said that the driver **might have fallen** asleep. _____ Also, he was not aware of the speed limit.

Pedro Dueñas, a passenger who has few injuries said: 'I was sitting in the corridor and I was sleeping. Suddenly, the driver lost control of the bus, everybody was screaming and finally, there was a big crash ahead'. _____ 'I was going to Ayacucho for Holy Week and I have never thought to be in this horrible situation!' He continued.

A relative of one of the passengers, Elizabeth Carrasco asked: 'Who is going to get in charge of this accident? The transportation company has not said a word yet! If my brother and sister-in-law hadn't been taken to the hospital by the authorities, they **would have died!**'

_____ Unfortunately, the ones who died were taken to the mortuary to be recognized by their relatives.

Police experts are searching for the real causes of this accident and people are claiming the company's support. This accident has plunged relatives, and the country mourns for one more accident on our highways; especially now that everyone is prepared for the days off from Holy Week. _____
