Daisy opened her eyes and saw that they were high up in the sky, next to some gray clouds.

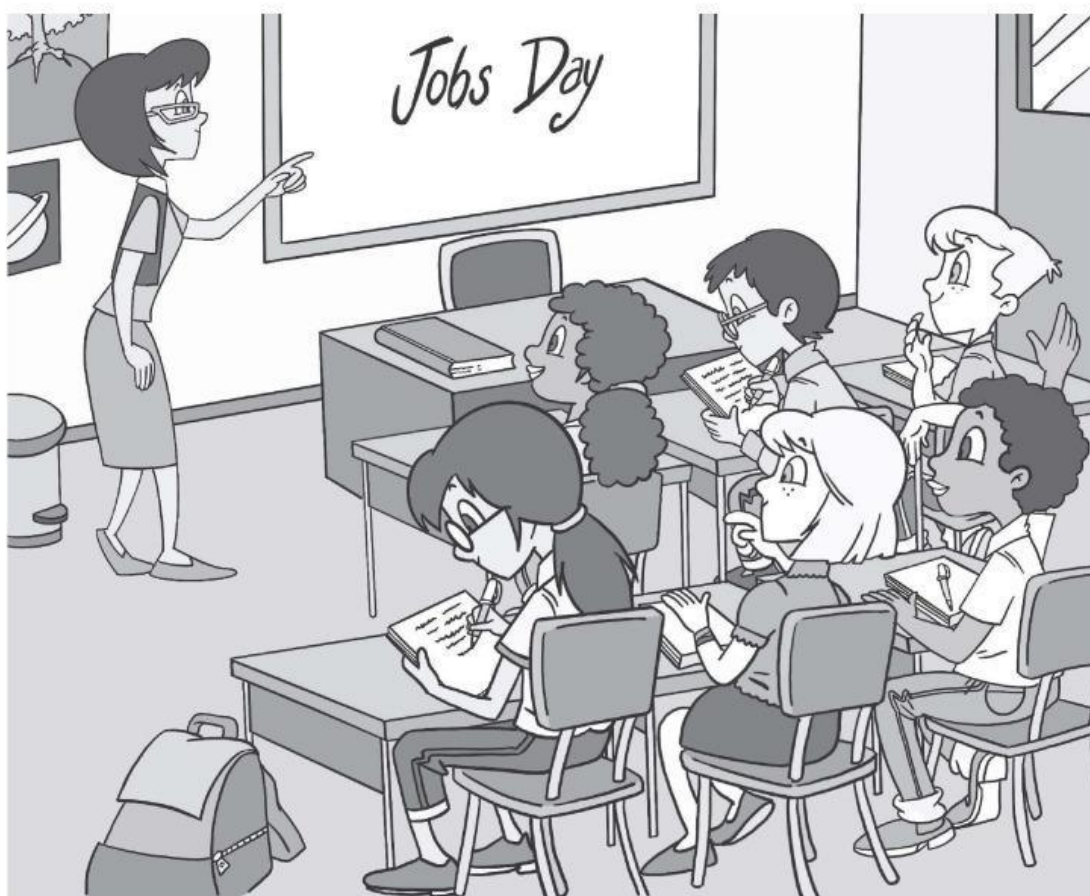
"Wow! Look at all those clouds, Mom," said Daisy. "It's going to rain!"
