AFRICA

The longest river in the world is in Africa. It's the Nile. Africa has three very long rivers. The Nile is about 6,600 km long, the Congo is about 4,700 km, and the Niger, in western Africa, is about 4,200 km long.



NORTH AND SOUTH AMERICA

The longest rivers in South America are the Amazon and the Rio-Paraná. The longest river in North America is the Mississippi-Missouri. The Amazon is about 6,400 km, the Rio-Paraná is about 4,900 km, and the Mississippi- Missouri is about 6,200 long.

ASIA

Asia also has lots of long rivers. The Yangtze in China is about 6,300 km long, the Yellow River is about 5,400 km, and the Lena in Russia is about 4,400 km long.
