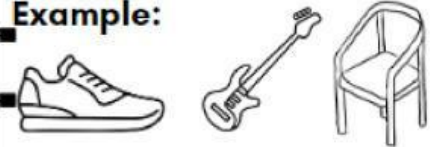
Living things need air, food, water, shelter and sunlight to survive.
