Affirmative form

Active voice : Subject + V.1 + Object

Passive voice : Object + is/am/are + V.3 + (by) Subject

Structure	Subject	Verb	Objective
Active	The dog	plays	the toy.
Structure	Object	Verb	Subject
Passive	The toy	is played	by the dog.

Structure	Subject	Verb	Objective	Place	Time
Active	He	eats	popcorn	in the cinema	on Sunday.
Structure	Object	Verb	Place	Time	Subject
Passive	Popcorn	is eaten	in the cinema	on Sunday	by him.

Affirmative form (2 Objects)

Active voice : Subject + V.1 + I.O. + D.O.

Passive voice : Indirect Object + is/am/are + V.3 + Direct object + (by) Subject

Structure	Subject	Verb	I.O.	D.O.
Active	He	gives	me	a flower.
Structure	I.O.	Verb	D.O.	Subject
Passive	I	am given	a flower	by him.

Active voice : Wh-question + do / does + Subject + V.1 ?

Passive voice : Wh-question + is/am/are + Subject + V.3 ?

* "who" in passive voice → by whom

Passive voice : Is/Am/Are + Subject + V.3 ?

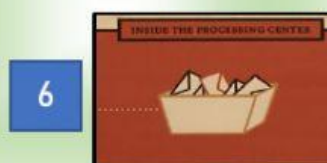
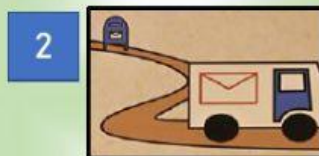
