Explanation	<p>Study the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Is there <b>anybody</b> at the window?</li> <li>❖ No, there isn't <b>anybody</b> there.</li> <li>❖ Is there <b>anybody</b> behind the curtain?</li> <li>❖ Yes, there's <b>somebody</b> there.</li> <li>❖ <b>Everybody</b> likes the ice creams.</li> <li>❖ <b>Nobody</b> likes the cakes.</li> </ul> <p><b>Form:</b> Some indefinite pronouns refer to people. They start with <b>any, some, no or every</b>. They end with the words <b>body or one</b>.</p> <p><b>Usage:</b> Indefinite pronouns are substitute words for people that cannot be or simply are not wanted to be named. So, they can be used instead of them .They are in the singular even if they denote several people.</p> <p><b>Examples:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is there <b>anybody</b> under the bed?</li> <li>• Yes, there's <b>somebody</b> there.</li> <li>• Is there <b>anybody</b> on the stairs?</li> <li>• No, there isn't <b>anybody</b> there.</li> <li>• Is there <b>anybody</b> in the car?</li> <li>• No, there isn't <b>anybody</b> there.</li> <li>• Is there <b>anybody</b> behind the tree?</li> <li>• Yes, there's <b>somebody</b> there.</li> <li>• <b>Everybody</b> is jumping.</li> <li>• <b>Nobody</b> is laughing.</li> </ul>
