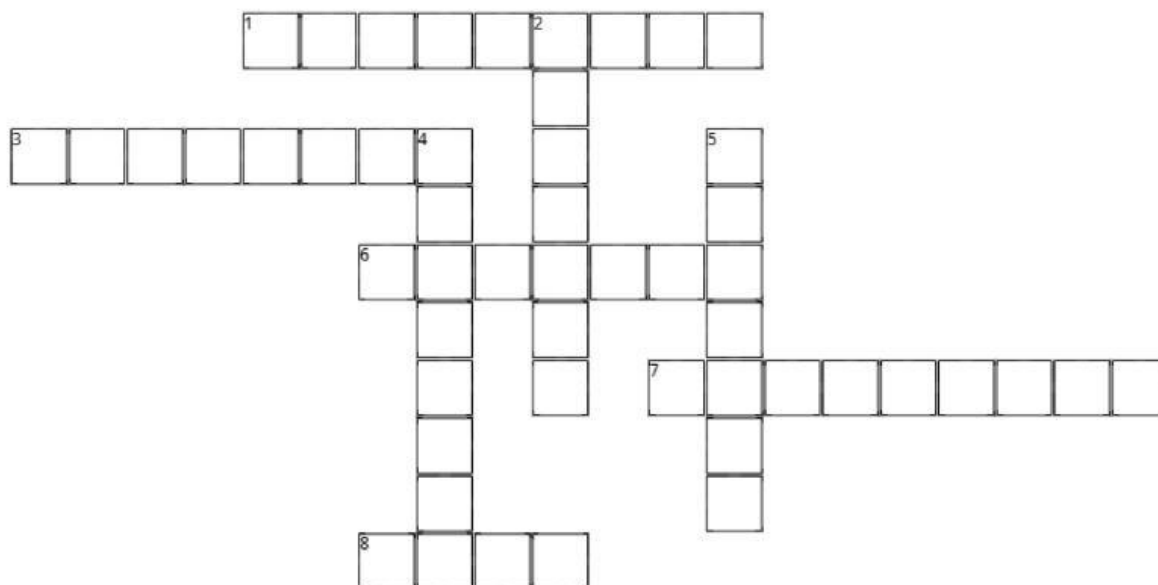

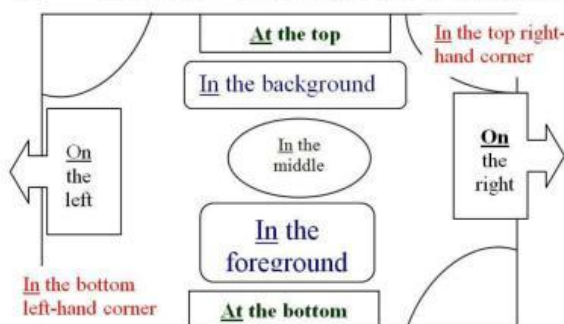
1. Visual art that operates in three dimensions, which is physically presented in the dimensions of height, width and depth.
